NOTICE: VERY, VERY IMPORTANT.

Be very careful not to rely on spell check when making Gospel Tracts with King James 1611

because, it will change the scriptures or corrupt them from the original text.

An example is Act 16:31. It will change "thy house." to "the house."

Always have committed staff to proof read all gospel tracts and checking for errors against several

King James 1611 Bibles. If you don't, and start publishing mistakes you won't be printing Gospel Tracts for very long.

Finally, I want to admonish you to take extreme care of the word of God. It is Holy, and Eternal

The Living Word of God. Be careful how you handle it. When printing don't leave scraps on the floor

to be stepped on. Treat it with reverence and respect. if YOU FIND ERRORS ON THE FREE TRACTS E-MAIL:

The PDF File description: Print only file. the Free software "Acrobat Reader" displays and prints the PDF file.

A-101 Sample Page; This is a single page that displays all the materials that you can print. If you, or your church discribes to use this free Gospel Tract Ministry, Use the Sample Blank page and past your Information on the top of the page.

Gospel Tracts:

Most of the Gospel tracts can be printed out on your computer with standard 8 1/2 x 11 paper then cut

in half (for 2 up) and folded in half, or cut twice for 4 up on a sheet. You can print the first page

then flip it over and print the back page. Imprint areas can be stamped with church info. or print the

front page on a good quality printer and past your church info. In each area and take it to the print shops.

If you have Aldus PageMaker software, you can use the originals and modify them to fit your needs.

There is one full page Giant print Gospel Tract GT_013 for the hard of seeing.

Several Gospel Tracts that

produce 2 copies on a sheet, and one three fold Gospel Tract that is 2 up on a page GT_024.

The Gospel Tract GT_017 "FREE TICKET TO HEAVEN" GOSPEL TRACT is a shingle sheet 8 1/2 X 11 colored card stock,

or "Cover stock" paper that needs to be first cut exactly in half, the cut again to trim out the small " Prepare

to Meet Your God" gospel Tracts. So one sheet yields 6 Gospel tracts per page. These are fun to hand out! I have

had people actually take them out of pocket at work because the saw the word "FREE" in my shirt pocket.

The Gospel Tract; GT_015 4 copies on an 8 1/2 X 11 sheet. "Thank You" is printed on green 67 lb bristle, or

colored card stock when folded can is used as a "table tent" wonderful Gospel Tract!

The Tract GT_012 "Don't wait for the Hearse to Take you to Church" is very popular. An unknown businessman wrote this Gospel Tract, in the 1980's. Many have copied this theme, and made bumper stickers etc. This gospel Tract also use as a table tent in restaurants etc.

The Tract GT_002 is 2 up, and for up on an 8 1/2 X 11 sheet. use a good paper, example 70 lb offset, something durable. This soul winner gospel Tract is a standard to lead others to Christ in personal evangelism, or visitation. The from picture is an actual real tome stone. I took this photo just north of Indianapolis, Indiana for a Bible College project and wrote my first gospel tract, which started this Free Gospel Tract Ministry. Some color photos are included in the "Clip Art" folder. Use them are you are led! The 2 up versions have bigger type and are easier to read, also the Giant Print GT_013.

The Tract GT_020 was written by Dr. Ed Cristy a missionary to France; Wonderful Gospel Tract. Great to use at events, prison work, to leave at Hospitals etc. God has used this Gospel Tract to win many to Christ. It has a racing story, and a clear Gospel Message.

the Tract GT_024 Mr. Waldron, a Bible college student wrote in 1988. This is the first time it was released. A personal story that I was reluctant to publish until now because it came "too close to home" yet now through all these years I saved the material! This Gospel tract is 2 up on a page and three fold 8 1/2 X 11 paper. Use good quality light paper. Good gospel Message, and will greatly use of the Lord as we all "sow the Word in the world". This Gospel Tract may still have some ruff spots that could be smoothed out. Please make suggestions!

The tract GT_022 "I care about where you'll spend eternity" written by Connie McGrew in early 1990's. This Gospel tract has been use by many churches. Mrs. McGrew Had me publish her gospel tract out of her burden for lost souls that would be left behind when the Lord Jesus returns for His bride the Church. It is printed on a arger sheet 8 1/2 X 17 paper then trimmed and folded in half. Produces one per sheet, so I included small tracts on the trim edges to use the waste material.

The tract GT_025 "Is Drunkenness a Sin" Written by Evangelist Al Kitchen in the 1990's. Powerful Gospel Tract. Great man of God stands against sinful works of the flesh, and Drunkenness is an awful destroyer of families, and destroys many lives.

The tract GT_11 "Does your Speech betray you?" 2 up on an 8 1/2 X 11 sheet. Deals with the teens cursing and swearing, and all the dirty talk! Art wilmoth wrote it; because the youth group did not teach the kids that swearing was wrong, nor did they instruct them to stop talking dirty perhaps out of fear of their parents. When people tell you they are born again Christians, and use "God's Name in vain"

Something is wrong with that picture! It's the sign of the end time! Carnal, backslidden, worldly "Christians" that are out of Fellowship though doing many church actives! Very Busy! This Gospel Tract has been rarely used at all. Please find a home for it!?

The Gospel Tract GT_007 Is a Gospel presentation of the Christmas story. Titled "Could be a Christmas Card?" I send this out to relatives during Christmas. Printed on Christmas color paper. Has a clear message of Salvation.

The Gospel Tract GT02_2a has no imprint area because of the list of items for for new believers. This Gospel Tract is the same as GT02_2up

Door Hanger:

Standard Door Hanger produces 4 on one sheet. The paper is a 67 lb bristle stock pre- die cut 8 1/2 x 14 that will run on small printing presses. You would be surprised the difference in quality that a print shop can produce over these quick print copy places, but I do recommend FedEx Kinko's for small runs, but some copy shops can not hold margins, for have then run a sample sheet first and carefully check it. IF THEY CANNOT HOLD TIGHT RESOLUTION ON MARGINS OF THE PAGE you may want to try a print shop. This is very important when printing 2 or 4 items on a page and cutting has to be accurate. Door hangers that are 4 on a sheet have 3 cut of equal size. One imprint layout fits many different Door Hangers Standard imprint area for Door Hangers files: dh_001, dh_002, dh_003, dh_005 & dh_006. Imprint areas for Door Hangers dh_007 and dh_008 are the same size. The cross clip art in dh_006 has John 3:16 displayed. You can change this to your favorite verse using the blank in the clip art folder. On the internet, you can search "Door Hanger Blanks" to get the best price. Large printing shops can save you money because they can print on large sheets of paper and die-cut the holes themselves. The pre die cut paper is quite expensive, and the price kept going up, but to reach you community Door Hangers are effective when people aren't home.

Note pads:

The message of the Gospel is printed on the back of the paper and the front of the note pad is open with no writing, for hand written notes. You can put a letterhead on the top of the page and give them out. The Lord willing the Lord will open their eyes to the Gospel message on the back of the page! Note pads are printed on the cheapest white paper, and padded with about 75 sheets with a backing, (Chip board), and glued with padding glue, or you can use Elmer's glue. A simple wooden padding press will keep all the sheets tightly and neatly pressed together, then glued together. After the glue dries, cut each pad and separate individual pads for use.

Yields, 6 pads per sheet on the "Romans Road" Note Pad NP_001, and 8 Note Pads per sheet on the "ABC" Note Pad. If you don't have a wooden padding press, there are many cheap designs that you can get at the Library, or off the Internet.

I have used a stack of books to weight the paper down instead of using a padding press, and glued the edge of the paper until I built my wooden padding press out of plywood. The books or lead weights work

ok. The glue is messy, and if you are not careful can get on you book!

Note: ABC stands for: A= Admit that you are a sinner. B= Believe on the Lord Jesus, and C= Call upon His Name.

Post Cards:

Each post card was designed after one of the Door Hangers. Once you visit a house and leave a door hanger, the idea was to follow up with a matching post card before a return visit. Endless possibilities

Post Card pc_001 has the same format as the Door Hanger dh_001 "Church Invite" with a picture of a church.

Post Card pc_002 has the same format as the Door Hanger dh_002 "Join Us". Mail is so expensive though that this concept is being used less as the price of postage goes up. E-mail has its advantages, but less personal. If you e-mailed your city, it would be advisable to use a company that handles mass e-mail, or you could be put on a black list for sending out Spam e-mail.

Therefore, mass mailing is still a very good option today though costly. Yet somehow our neighborhoods must be reach with the gospel! Churches are spending billions of dollars a year on foreign missions, and not winning their neighborhoods to Christ and losing their churches because they have no new members!

If your church can even hire a full time worker, just to spread the gospel to the neighborhood, it would be worth it! While we can, do everything to win as many as you can to Christ. Prayer is the first step! Fasting and prayer! Then go out and evangelize! And then bring them in to church!
