"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord Shall be saved." Romans 10:13.

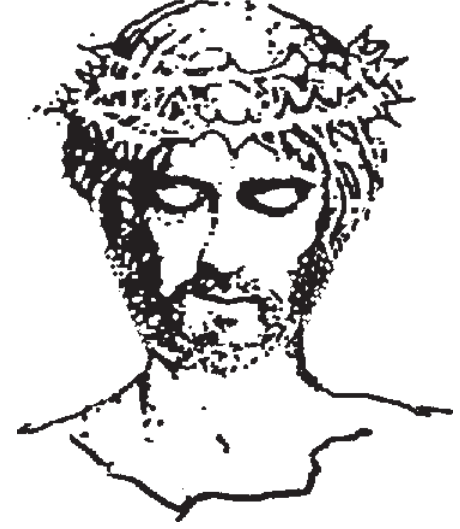
